## **CHARITABLE GRANTS CRITERIA**

The following Criteria are for the guidance of applicants for a Charitable Grant from the Auckland Softball Foundation Charitable Trust. The Trustees have the sole discretion as to who is granted funds and these criteria and other considerations can, and will be, taken into account by the Trustees when considering applications.

### **WHO CAN APPLY?**

Any society, association charitable trust or organisation that is incorporated or legally constituted, and whose rules do not allow money, property or any other benefits to be distributed to its members.

*[If individuals wish to apply, they must do so via a body as identified above]*

### **WHAT CAN BE APPLIED FOR?**

Funds are available for any charitable purpose that benefits the Community and is in accordance with the Objects of the Auckland Softball Foundation Charitable Trust, the full detail of which can be seen on the website [www.asfct.org.nz](http://www.asfct.org.nz)

In brief these are :-

- To encourage pupils and students and the public at large to play softball;
- To provide lectures, demonstrations and coaching of softball;
- To provide facilities and equipment of every kind relating to the playing of softball;
- To enhance the development of the game of softball throughout New Zealand;

*[At this point of the development of the Foundation, the Trustees will only consider applications from bodies which are based, and operate in, the Auckland Softball region.]*

## **MULTI – YEAR PROJECTS**

The Foundation will only fund multiple period projects if the full amount of the project through to completion is applied for in the initial application and ASFCT has those full funds available at the time of application.

*[At this point of the development of the Foundation, it is unlikely that the Trustees will consider multi-year projects.]*

## **ORGANISATION PLANS**

The Trustees wish to support projects which have lasting benefit to softball. To this end, applicants must be able to demonstrate how their project(s) fits into the Overall Plans of their organisation and of the sport of softball.

## **MEASUREMENT OF SUCCESS**

The Trustees wish to ensure that any funds allocated are spent for the purpose intended and that the success or otherwise of the funding can be adequately measured. Therefore applications must show clear measurable milestones and measurable goals and objectives and show how the successful use of the funds is to be measured.
